

The Public Risk Management Association (PRIMA) is accepting scholarship applications to assist qualified Non-Risk Managers to attend the 2022 PRIMA Annual Conference. Non-Risk Managers have the responsibility of supervising and directing the position of Risk Managers in his/her public entity, but do not have the responsibility of the day to day to job functions of the Risk Manager.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Monday, March 7, 2022

Scholarship Benefits:

Each scholarship recipient receives \$1,500 in financial assistance to be applied to a complimentary registration to the PRIMA's Annual Conference plus **THREE** nights of lodging and a \$250 stipend.

Criteria:

Applicants will be judged based on the following criteria:

- Be a leadership level manager with a public entity, including positions such as CFO, Director, Executive Director, Deputy Director or Superintendent for at least two years;
- Financial need or severity of budget constraints;
- Demonstrate experience in supervising or directing employees in the risk management field;
- Years of public sector risk management experience;
- Have not attended PRIMA's Annual Conference within the last three years;
- Be administratively responsible for providing risk management services to the public entity;
- **MUST** include your current resume.



You do not have to be a PRIMA member to apply. Only one individual per organization may receive a scholarship in a single year.

Application Procedure:

Applicants must complete the Non-Risk Manager Scholarship Application Form on page 2. The application must include all supporting documentation.

Completed application MUST be received by Monday, March 7, 2022
Applications received after this date will be rejected.

Recipients also will be asked to complete a brief evaluation of the scholarship program at the end of the conference. This scholarship is not transferable and in the case that the applicant cannot attend [PRIMA's 2022 Annual Conference](#), the recipient must notify PRIMA within five days of receiving notification of the scholarship award.
